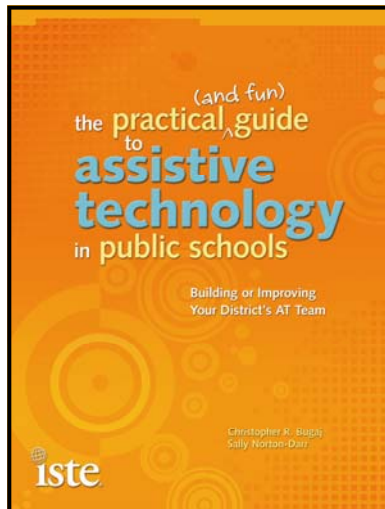


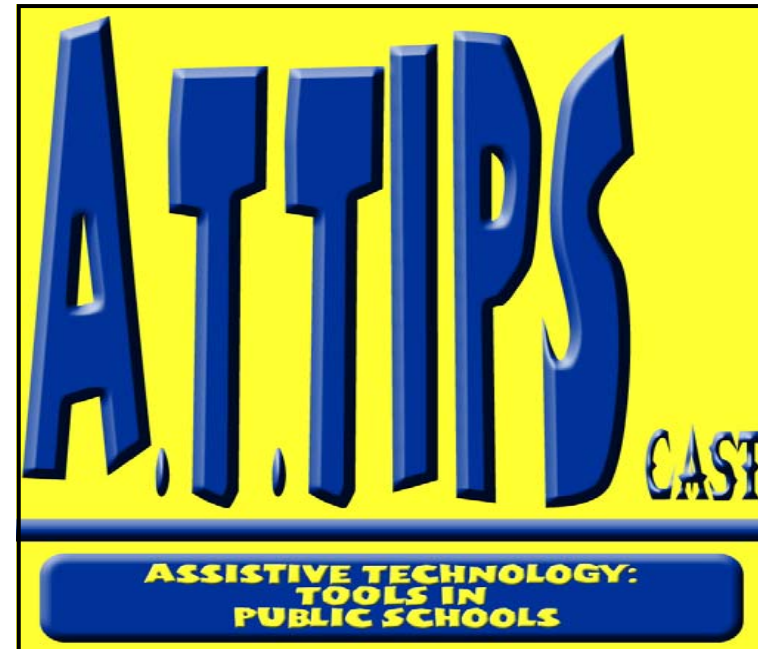
## Buy The Book!

The *A.T.TIPSCAST – Assistive Technology: Tools in Public Schools*, is a podcast that features episodes pertaining to inexpensive (often free) tools that can be used to assist students who are struggling in school.
