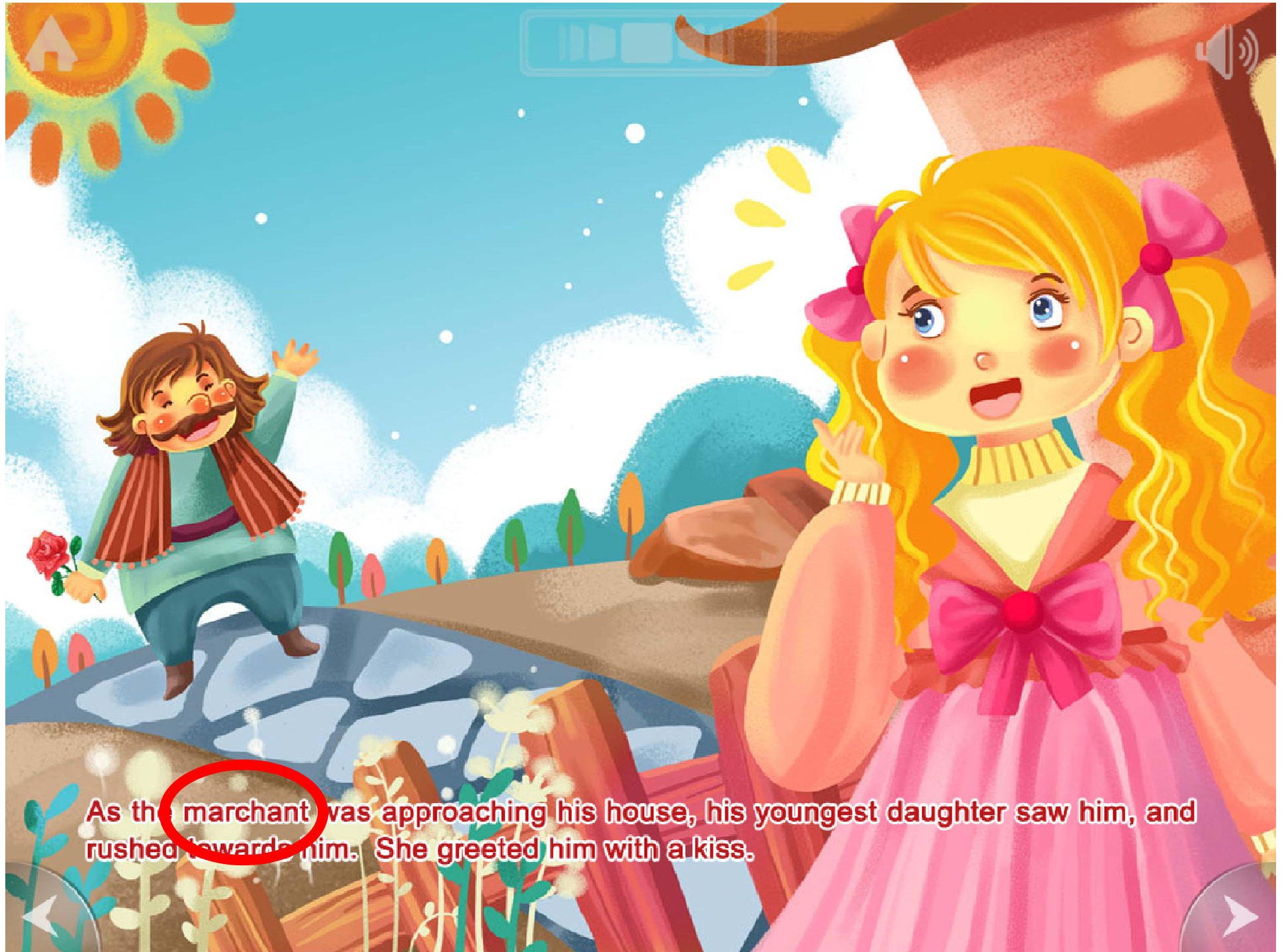


The merchant told his servant, "Ah! How lucky I am!" Then, he sent his servant to pluck a rose for him from the rose garden.



Just **when** they were ready to leave with the rose, a fearsome lion rushed out and roared, "Who dares to steal my rose? I shall eat him."



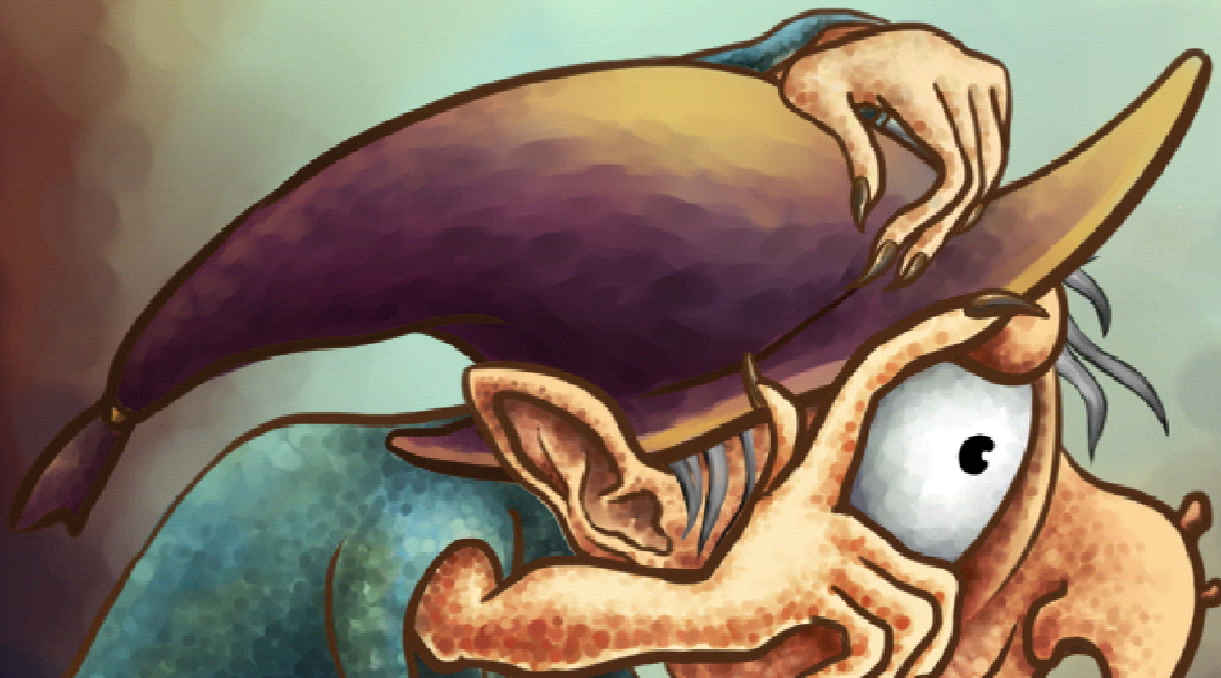
As the **merchant** was approaching his house, his youngest daughter saw him, and rushed towards him. She greeted him with a kiss.
